Fortnight for Freedom Talking Points Prayer Rally at the Lincoln Statue at the State Capitol Springfield, Illinois July1, 2014

- S.S.P.: We gather to give thanks for blessings received
 - I. Our Fortnight for Freedom gathering here is called a "Prayer Rally"
 - A. We understand "rally" as calling people together and encouraging them in a common purpose; our purpose here: religious liberty
 - B. We understand prayer in many ways: petition, supplication, worship, glory, praise, repentance and thanksgiving
 - C. Today we give thanks for yesterday's Supreme Court decision in the *Hobby Lobby* case
 - II. Some things to note about *Hobby Lobby* case
 - A. The fight for religious liberty protection in our country is not just a Catholic issue
 - 1. Owners of *Hobby Lobby* are evangelical Christians;
 - 2. Owners of Conestoga Wood Specialties in Pennsylvania are Mennonite
 - B. Contrary to what many of the media and on the left are saying, this case is not about contraception
 - 1. The plaintiffs had no objection to contraceptives, but did object to provision of drugs that induce abortion
 - 2. This is significant because there is no legal difference between chemical abortion and surgical abortion
 - 3. If the government could have forced people to pay for chemical abortions, they would have been able to force people to pay for surgical abortions as well.
 - 4. Thank God the Supreme Court said no to this!
 - III. Our struggle is not over for the freedom to serve the poor and vulnerable
 - A. Little Sisters of the Poor case will not be decided until next year
 - B. We must continue to be vigilant, speak out and pray for religious liberty.
 - IV. May God give us this grace. Amen.
