## **§4101 PASTOR EMERITUS**

## §4101.1. Honorary Title

**4101.1.** *Policy.* "Pastor Emeritus" is an honorary title awarded at the discretion of the Diocesan Bishop to a senior priest upon his resignation as pastor (cf. canon 185).

## **Procedures**

- 1. A Pastor Emeritus need not reside in the parish in which he completed his assignment and may continue involvement in any parish setting. A Pastor Emeritus will vacate the pastor's quarters if the quarters are needed for the newly appointed pastor or parochial administrator.
- 2. When residing within the parish of his final appointment, the term "Pastor Emeritus" is used. When residing within another parish, the term "Pastor Emeritus of \_\_\_\_\_" is used.
- 3. A Pastor Emeritus may be recognized for multiple pastorates of his last assignment.
- 4. The Pastor Emeritus may reside within the parish in which he completed his assignment provided that there is space available and the pastor or parochial administrator approves of his residence.
- 5. A Pastor Emeritus is also a "Senior Priest."
