

§4200 PRIESTS' RESIDENCE

§4201 ORDINARY ARRANGEMENT

4201.1. Policy Priests shall live in the housing provided by the parish or institution to which they are assigned.

§4202 EXCEPTION FOR SERIOUS REASONS

In certain circumstances, serious reasons relating to a priest's personal life or ministry may compel him to petition for an alternate residence.

4202.1. Policy A priest shall have the opportunity to petition the Bishop, his Vicar General or Vicar for Priests for an alternate residence.

4202.2. Policy The Vicar General, in consultation with the Dean and Vicar for Priests, is authorized to approve another ecclesiastical residence for a parish priest after consulting other parish priests involved. Part of this consultation shall be a written agreement between the priest who is going to live elsewhere, the pastor, and other parish priests regarding mutual responsibilities.

§4203 NON-ECCLESIASTICAL RESIDENCE

4203.1. Policy Living in housing independent of an ecclesiastical residence shall require the approval of the Bishop.
