Diocese of Springfield in Illinois Request for Distribution of Funds from the Religious Education and Catechist Formation Endowment Catechist Formation Grant

Catechetical Leadership Personnel (Directors or Coordinators of Religious Education) of our diocese assist parents in their role as the primary educators of their children. DREs and CREs do this by coordinating and directing various religious education programs in the parishes of the diocese. These programs assist parents and all adult parishioners in their own faith development as well as the faith development of youth. Also, these DREs/CREs are responsible for the training of the catechists – those who actually teach and share their faith with the participants of parish catechetical programs – by providing catechists formation opportunities.

It is essential that our parishes have qualified personnel to achieve all the responsibilities of the administrative position of Director or Coordinator of Religious Education. It is also equally essential that the catechists of our parishes be qualified to share their faith and the teachings of the Catholic Church with conviction and accuracy.

Harvest of Thanks, Springtime of Hope Capital Campaign:

To assist in the formation of catechetical leaders and catechists for their respective roles, an endowment for Catechist Formation and Religious Education was created through the *Harvest of Thanks, Springtime of Hope* capital campaign. Money from this endowment is available to:

- Assist in the professional training of the Catechetical Leadership Personnel of the diocese;
- Support catechists in attaining or advancing their certification in the Diocesan Catechist Formation Process;
- Supply media and catechetical/adult enrichment materials; and
- Enrich programs for adult faith formation

Rationale:

Two of the areas that the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois named in the case statement of the *Harvest of Thanks, Springtime of Hope* campaign as worthy of endowment monies are **catechist formation** and **adult faith formation**. The Office for Catholic Education is responsible for administering monies for projects that advance formation opportunities in either of these categories. The **Catechist Formation Grant** has been created to help distribute these monies.

The intention of these grants is to help fund innovative and effective efforts at the parish level that will foster and sustain adult formation as part of the larger catechetical mission of the parish. Grant money could be used for staff development, catechist formation, or leadership development. Grants will not be awarded for salaries, capital improvements, previously purchased items, participant costs to/from an event, or non-catechetical costs such as hospitality for participants and/or the planning team. Requests for media or supplemental materials for adult formation should be made on the **Media and Enrichment Materials Grant** available from the Office for Catholic Education.

Eligibility:

- Grants will be awarded to parish efforts that fulfill a **definite catechetical plan** for catechist formation or adult faith formation that helps in attaining and advancing certification in the Diocesan Catechist Formation Process.
- > This catechetical plan must include specific goals the project seeks to accomplish.
- Funding for reasonable speaker expenses such as stipends, travel, lodging and meals, may be eligible for funds.
- Expenses for non-catechetical aspects of a catechetical project are not eligible e.g. venue fees, participant lodging, meals or travel, or other expenses that are not catechetical in nature.
- Other ineligible expenses include salaries, capital improvements, previously purchased items, participant costs to/from an event, or hospitality costs for participants and/or planning team.

Procedure:

- Applications for the Catechist Formation Grant will be mailed to pastors and parochial administrators in March and be available on the diocesan website.
- > Completed applications must be received by the Office for Catholic Education by **April 30**.
- > A committee coordinated by the Office for Catholic Education will review all applications by **May 7**.
- > Notification of the review committee's decision will be sent to the applicant by May 15.
- Parishes receiving an award will receive an agreement form which must be completed and returned by June 15 before funds can be issued.
- A final report about the project funded must be completed and submitted to the Office for Catholic Education by the end of the fiscal year in which the project was implemented along with any unused funds.
- The Office for Catholic Education will complete an **annual report** of the amount of grant money dispersed to parishes and a summary of the projects these grants helped fund.

Regulations:

- > All requests for grants must be submitted on the application form provided.
- > All applications should be type written or clearly printed in ink. A fillable PDF version is available.
- > Documentation should be included with the application to show how amounts were determined.
- > Applications must be **received by April 30** for consideration.

Other Information:

- Parishes may submit one Catechist Formation Grant application per year. Additional applications from other programs of the Religious Education and Catechist Formation Endowment are permitted.
- Awards are based on funds available and number of qualified applications received, therefore, partial grants may be awarded.
- The proposed project(s) must outline a plan that helps catechists earn credit toward certification in the Catechist Formation Process.
- ▶ Individual applications for the **Catechist Formation Grant** should not exceed \$1,000.
- Grants for catechetical materials (e.g. subscriptions, DVDs, books, etc.) should be requested on the Media and Enrichment Materials Grant application.
- If it becomes necessary to change the original plan after a grant is awarded, the Office for Catholic Education must approve prior to implementing the change.
- New grants will not be awarded until the previous grant is completed and final report submitted to the Office for Catholic Education.
