The St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Medal is an award presented by the Diocesan Catholic Committee on Scouting to adult leaders in Girl Scouts USA and Camp Fire USA who have made significant contributions to the spiritual needs of Catholic members in these organizations. This award is intended to recognize notable contributions in Catholic Youth Ministry through the Girl Scout USA and/or Camp Fire USA programs at the local level.

CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

- Exemplary member of the parish, supportive of the mission of the local parish community
- Registered member of the organization served with a minimum of three years of service
- Participates in activities which contribute to the spiritual development of Catholic members of GSUSA or CFUSA (i.e. retreat weekends, days of recollection, Scout Sunday, etc.)
- Promotes the religious recognition programs available to Catholic members
- Participates in adult spiritual motivation days
- Is responsible for Catholic members fulfilling their Sunday Mass obligation as appropriate while participating in organization functions
- Contributes to the life of the parish

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Nominations may be made using the form below by anyone who lives in the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois who is not the nominee's spouse or other immediate family member. An award selection committee appointed by the chairperson of the Diocesan Catholic Committee on Scouting reviews all nominations and recommends adults for this award based on the nominee's service to Catholic Scouting as one of the Church's ministries to youth. The deadline to submit a nomination is December 1.
